Since that time the library has received all federal publications distributed by the Government Printing Office's Federal Depository Library Program. The State Library is the Regional Depository Library for Washington and Alaska.

There are a total of 29 additional Depository Libraries in Washington and Alaska. These Depository Libraries choose the GPO distributed publications they will receive and retain in their collections. The documents must then be retained for at least five years.
